
More Activity on Plume Superfund Site

GRANTS, NM - According to CH2M (now Jacobs) officials, the contractor for the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Grants Chlorinated Solvents Plume Superfund Site (the site), will continue cleanup activities for the groundwater remediation project at the site continues on Tuesday, May 12, 2020.

Cleanup activities will consist of groundwater cleanup activities using mobile equipment on city streets and shoulders from through June 1, 2020 at various temporary locations. They will also require limited road and shoulder closures during work to allow for the protection of personnel, equipment, and the general public.

Starting on Monday, May 11, lane closures are expected along First Street between Jefferson Avenue and Monroe Avenue. In addition, along Anderman Street south of Washington Avenue the week of May 18 and along Truman Avenue the week of May 25. Lane closures and shoulder work will occur from approximately 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily and the roads will fully reopen at the completion of the work day. No overnight road closures are anticipated.

Related maps show road closures and shoulder work areas, as well as the typical traffic control plans which indicate the placement of the traffic control equipment.




